

Appendix No. 1
to the Terms and Conditions of Services of International Road Transport of
Shipments rendered by Raben Polska sp. z o.o.

"Goods excluded from transport in international distribution"

The Carrier does not render transport services of the following goods and items:

- weapons, ammunition, munitions, etc.
- strategic goods pursuant to EU legislation
- list of dangerous goods:

Class 1 Explosive substances and articles

Class 2 Gases with classification other than UN1044, UN1057, UN1950 and UN2037 (classification codes A and F)

Class 4.1 Self-reactive substances which require controlled temperature (classification code SR2), Self-reactive substances which do not require controlled temperature with numbers UN: 3221, 3222

Class 4.2 Substances of Packing Group I

Class 5.2 Organic peroxides which require controlled temperature (classification code P2), Organic peroxides which do not require controlled temperature (classification code P1) with numbers UN: 3101, 3102

Class 6.1 Substances of PG I (PG – Packing Group) transported by sea

Class 6.2 Infectious substances

Class 7 Radioactive materials

Class 9 Materials with elevated temperature (classification codes M9 and M10)

- bulk cargo (full container loads and groupage);
- liquid materials;
- oversized cargo;
- resettlement property;
- spirits;

- goods which require controlled temperature in the standard system of groupage network;
- tobacco products;
- works of art; precious stones and jewellery; precious metals;
- animals;
- securities;
- human bodies, mortal remains;
- postal parcels;
- soot,
- potted plants,
- perishables,
- frozen goods,
- waste,
- shipments which require specialised transport or storage, in particular medical products pursuant to Polish Pharmaceutical Law.
- goods especially prone to damage in road transport
- and any other goods excluded from transport pursuant to Polish Transport Law Art. 36 (Journal of Laws No. 272 of 1984).

In the case of loading a shipment containing the abovementioned goods, the Carrier shall not be liable for damage to such goods and he shall have the right to refuse to accept such goods on site.

Additionally, the loading party shall be liable for damage to the goods of other customers or the property of the Carrier by loading such a shipment and shall bear administrative pecuniary penalties or civil liability imposed on the Carrier by Polish authorities.
