Saudade with fado

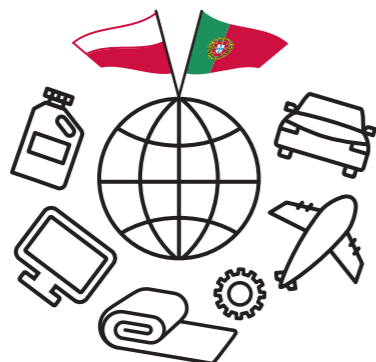

Vasco da Gama *Bridge*

The Vasco da Gama Bridge in Lisbon is the longest bridge in Europe. It is 17 km of road in the blue of the sea and the sky but it's not enough to fit the whole **Raben fleet, which set one truck after another, would create a 47 km long line.**

At the edge of Europe

The westernmost point of Europe is Cabo da Roca, or Cape Roca, located in the Sintra-Cascais National Park. The cliffs here reach up to 100 metres above the sea level.



Beyond *the horizon*

Although Prince Henry, known as the Navigator, was afraid of sailing, he founded a navigation school in Sagres in the 15th century. He also financed shipbuilding, development of cartography and maritime expeditions. The graduates from Sagres were the first explorers to set out into the unknown: first along the African coasts, then to India and Brazil.

Not only for *bookworms*

Lisbon is home to the oldest bookshop in the world – Bertrand, founded in 1732.



Energy to the third power

Water, wind and sun satisfy almost 70% of energy needs of Portugal, making it one of the leaders in renewable energy sources. **Raben also takes care of the environment, e.g. as part of the program "e-Invoice = higher culture" where for each consent to receiving e-invoices, Raben plants a tree on behalf of the customer.**



Rails

The first tram line on the Iberian Peninsula was launched in 1895 in Porto. **Raben is investing in more modern means of transport. For example, it is introducing CityLiner trailers adapted to urban areas which, thanks to the capacity of 27 pallets (compared to the previously used 15-pallet ones), reduce the number of trucks in cities.**

In Portugal, a day is lost without a visit to the café. In the morning, you drop in for coffee, around noon for lunch, and in the evening, you can have dinner at a *marisqueira* offering fish and seafood dishes. Cafés are also a favourite meeting place for seniors.

Madeira has been produced for over 300 years now. Its foreign sales account for almost half of its export revenue. They say madeira was the favourite alcohol of George Washington, Benjamin Franklin and Thomas Jefferson. The latter made a toast with it on the day the United States Declaration of Independence was announced.



ATM at your service
