



GOULASH SOUP

|--|--|
| 1 onion | 3 and 1/2 glass of broth |
| 1 clove of garlic | 1 red pepper |
| 2 spoons of butter | 3 potatoes |
| 300 g of pork forend | 500 ml of tomato passata |
| 1 teaspoon of ground sweet pepper | 1 spoon of tomato concentrate |
| 1 teaspoon of dried thyme | 2 spoons of chopped parsley |
| 1/2 glass of white wine | Salt, pepper, pinch of ground hot pepper |

PREPARATION:

Prepare the dish in the pot you will use for cooking the soup. Stew the onion and garlic cut in half in butter. Add cubed meet and fry. Add spaces and fry for a while longer. Add wine and stew for **1-2 minutes**, add hot broth and cook everything.

Add tomato passata and concentrate. Season with salt and pepper, cover the pot and cook **for hour**.

After that time, add cubed pepper and potatoes, stir, cover and cook **for approx. half an hour** until potatoes are soft. Sprinkle with parsley. **Bon Appetit!**

Do you like peppers? You can try a **thousand different kinds of them in Hungary!** The hottest of them is 100 times hotter than a chilli pepper.



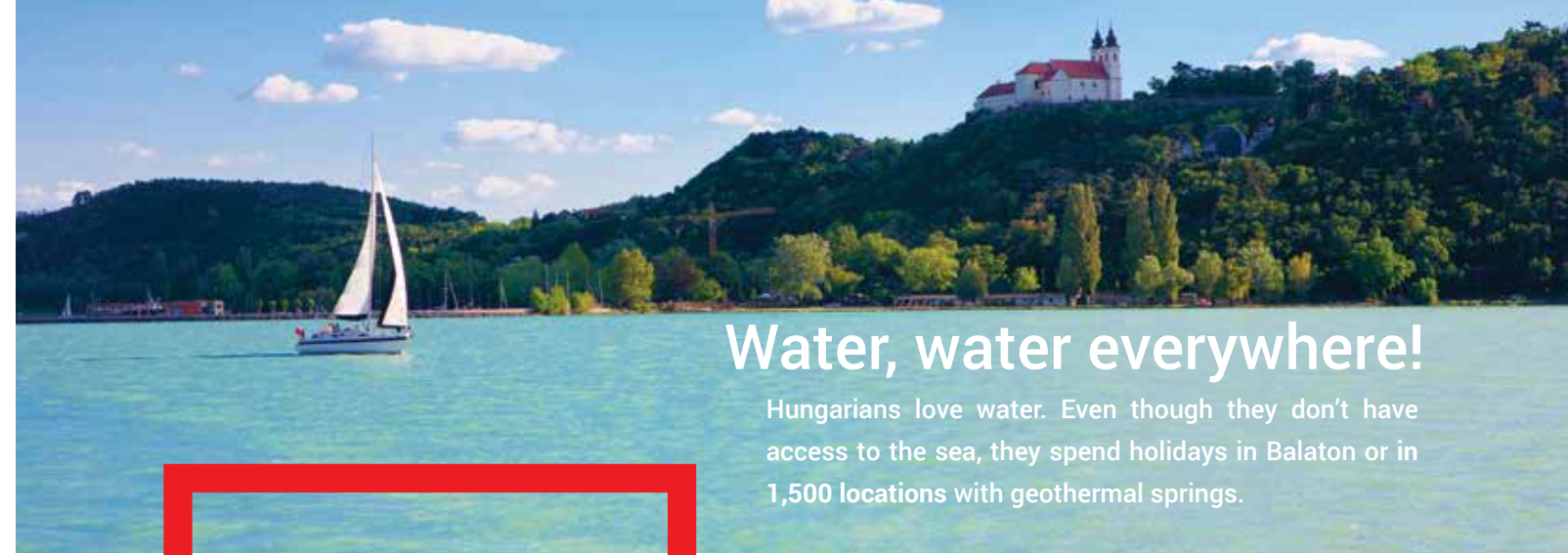
December 13 - Luca Day
